THE MAY PAINT-IN WAS GREAT!

Our May paint-in project was a Geranium with Hummingbird watercolor project taught by Judy Lopez. For several of our members this was their first exposure to watercolor. Painting with watercolor is quite different than painting with acrylics. The colors are softer after the paper is dry. You usually cannot add a second layer until the paper is dry. We tried a pearl iridescent over some of the colors. Liquidity of the paints affects the intensity of the colors. It was fun to try a new painting technique.

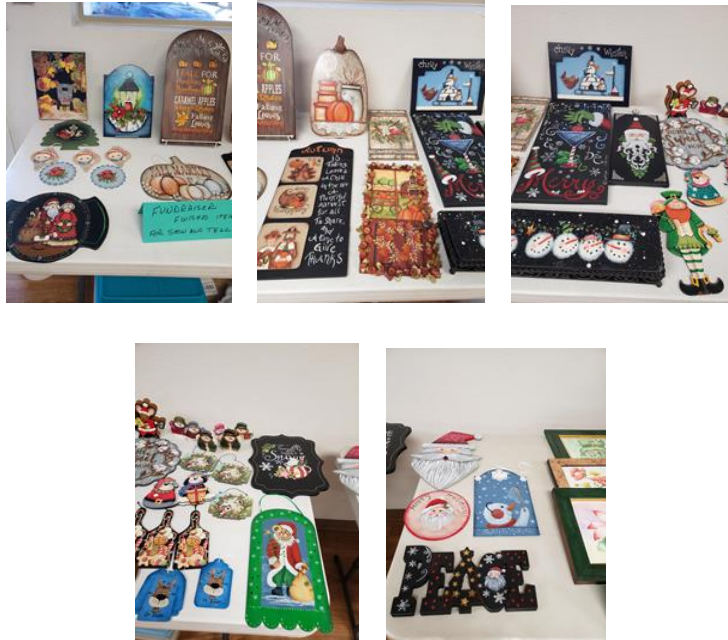

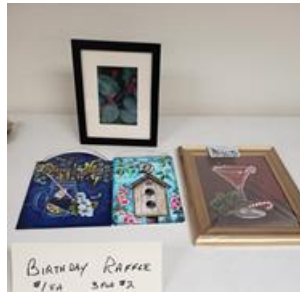
