THE FEBRUARY PAINT-IN WAS FUN!

The February Paint-In was actually a Pencil-In. It might have seemed unusual to be creating a warm pumpkin piece in winter, but it did warm our hearts and got us to see some different colors after the winter holidays. Reggie did a thorough job in teaching this colored pencil class. There were a few new artists there, so she kindly and patiently explained some colored pencil basics. This was a true help for us newbies and allowed us all to complete a beautiful piece. The suede board was an excellent choice to showcase the softness of the pencil work while creating a nice background. These 18 artists were fueled with a buffet of tasty treats and good company.







MARCH

The March paint-in will be practicing strokework taught by Pat Kaminsky. This is to refresh us on strokework before the seminar. We will be painting on the front and back of the round surface that is \$1. There is no pattern, and the prep is just painting both sides black.

In addition to your regular supplies bring the following: Be sure to bring an assortment of round brushes (I used a #4 & 6 round), a liner brush and a flat brush. The flat brush should be the size you want your circle to be for the flower.

Bring the following paints: White, your favorite red and green paints, and the paints you want to paint your flower and leaves, and the black paint you base coated your round.





APRIL Date change to April 13th

The April paint-in is a Firefly Project designed by Holly Hanley taught by Marica Mallicoat. Cost of pattern is \$5. I will need to know who wants one so I can order from Holly. Round surface of your choice, 12-16 inches. Original pattern suggests an outdoor stepping stone, 16 inches. I used a round wooden surface purchased from Hobby Lobby. I will demo on a terra cotta plate that usually goes under a pot. This can be purchased at Home Depot or Walmart.





LIBT will be hosting a seminar with Linda Sharp on Friday and Saturday, May 31 & June 1, 2024 9:00 am - 5:00 pm Doors open at 8:30 am At Trinity Lutheran Church 3950 N. Valorie Drive, Prescott Valley, AZ

Linda has been painting and teaching for over 40 years and has taught classes all over the country, including the SDP National Convention, Portland and Seattle Mini-Conventions, Las Vegas Creative painting Convention, HOOT, New England Traditions Convention as well as for chapters and retreats, both in person and n Zoom.

Cost for each day will be \$40.00 with no additional cost for non-members. Linda Sharp teaches with Traditions Paint. Therefore, there is an additional palette fee of \$5.00 each day. Students will receive their own paint in cubbies which are labeled and contain all mixtures and colors listed in the instructions.

The Friday project is a Give Thanks Pumpkin Plate on a pumpkin shaped surface. We will be ordering the surfaces for those who want them for \$7.00 each.

The Saturday project is called Enchanted Christmas on a 12" double beaded plate. We will be ordering the surfaces for those who want them for \$22.00 each. Of course, you may use a surface of your choice.

All class and surface fees are due in March. Prep instructions and line drawing will be provided prior to the seminar. They may be downloadable.

For lunch we will have a Pot Luck each day. Friday will be salads and Saturday will be sandwiches. Water and snacks provided by LIBT.

We will Zoom for any participants out of the area.
